With reference to the case of the steamer "HALLAND", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them at their Meeting today the Surveyors' Reports, from which it appears that a general examination has been made of the vessel, as a result of which it is considered she is in a fit condition to trade for a further period of six months, and accordingly a record "Examined L.R.5.40" will be made against the vessel's name in the Society's Register Book, as being indicative of the nature of the survey now held.

It is understood that you will make arrangements for the tailshaft survey to be carried out at the first opportunity.
