With reference to your First Entry Reports, Nos. 19497 and 19510, of surveys held on the steamers "HARLINGEN" and "HARDINGHAM", I have to request that you will be good enough to let me know the Brake Horse Power of the exhaust turbine, this being required in computing the Nominal Horse Power.

This question will not affect the fees to be paid by the Engine Builders, and in this connexion I think it well to refer you to the correspondence which took place between us last month.

In regard to the case of the "HARDINGHAM", I shall be glad if you will enquire of the Greenock Surveyors and let me know whether reverse bars have been fitted to the deep framing forward.
