"HANNAH"

We are in receipt of your memo of 6th inst., regarding the Swedish steamer "HANNAH". When this ship was dry docked in June of last year the screw shaft liner was examined and surveyors were satisfied that it would serve for another year, reckoning on normal trading. As it happened, however, trading has not been normal and over the year the ship has been laid up for lengthy periods. Actually, since the examination the ship has spent only 46 days out of the last 365 at sea, whereas normally in the same period she would have nearly 200 days out of the 365 at sea.

At the present time the "HANNAH" is running for the Ministry of Shipping and being urgently required for their service, we cannot see that there will be an early opportunity of renewing the liner, but we have the question in mind and will attend to it as soon as we can.
