Dear Sirs,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 7th instant respecting the Swedish Steamer "HANNAH", the contents of which have been noted.

With regard thereto I have to inform you that this vessel is expected to sail from Yarmouth to your port to-day, where it is understood the alterations for the carriage of timber deck cargoes will be carried out, and I have to request that you will be good enough to forward to this Office full particulars of these alterations. I shall also be glad to learn whether the auxiliary means of steering is enclosed in the deckhouse on the raised quarter deck aft, and the dimensions and particulars of this house should be given.

I have to add that owing to the presence of cargo in the holds, it was not possible to obtain details of any sanitary discharge pipes when the vessel was surveyed at Yarmouth, and I shall therefore be glad to receive full particulars of these pipes.
