- (1) Collision with S.S. "JESSIE MANN" in Gourock Roads on the 18th December, 1940;
- (2) Heavy weather encountered in the Atlantic on 5, 6 & 7th Decr., 1940
- (3) " " " " Gourock Roads on 23rd January, 1941

and that I have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, and

that I have **Recommended** that she be continued as at present classed in the Society's Register Book, viz: local with fresh record of survey 2.41, subject to permanent repairs to shell plating in way of humpers in sheer and strake below and in way of bridge house (P.S.) and indented plating (S.S.) No. 3 in sheerstrake and No. 3 from bridge front in first below being carried out, also to indented shell plating etc. in 2nd and 3rd strakes below sheer (S.S.F.) and indented steel plate No. 2 and shell plates A2 (P & S) being gault with and waste pipes (P & S) being renewed at Owners' convenience being fit to carry
