I have to report that I have surveyed the Dutch
Motor vessel "HENRICA" of Rotterdam. O.N. ----
on this date.

I have compared the arrangements on board the ship with those given in the original freeboard report and I have found them to be in agreement therewith or equivalent thereto, and the whole to be in efficient condition.

The special Survey No.2 has now been completed concurrently with the freeboard Survey and the vessel will be recommended to remain as classed with fresh record of Survey 6-39 and notation S.S. No. 2-39

The original freeboard certificates have been transmitted to the Dutch Authorities for extensions by them until the end of the year of grace allowed for the next Special Survey ultimo June 1944.

The freeboard marking has been verified and found to agree with the freeboards given on certificate No. dated
