With reference to your letter of the 24th instant respecting the steamer "HARMODIUS" I have to report as follows:-

- (1) All air pipes on freeboard deck have been fitted with ball valves as previously approved.
- (2) The panelled wood doors in the machinery casing on the freeboard deck have been reinforced with steel plates, and are capable of being manipulated from both sides.

I have to add that the lifelines in the after well are efficiently supported.
