Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 6th instant, respecting the fees chargeable to the Admiralty in the case of the Steamer "HARMODIUS" (Glasgow First Entry Report No. 39259), I have to inform you that the proportion of the fees which will be chargeable to the Department of the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding for the survey of the Hull and Machinery of this vessel up to the time of transfer to private ownership will be 50% of the difference between the fees as a Standard Vessel and the ordinary classification fees in the case of the Hull, and 25% in the case of the Machinery, which in this case will amount to £59 and £17 respectively.

An account has to-day been rendered to the Ministry of Shipping for these fees, and on payment your account will be credited accordingly.

I shall therefore be glad if you will kindly see that the necessary entries are now made in the Glasgow Rough Fee and Debit Books in the usual way.
