With reference to your letter of yesterday's date and to my subsequent telephone conversation with Mr. Mackirdy relative to the steamer "FAIRPORT", I enclose herewith some documents which have been loaned by the Owners referring to the survey held on this vessel by Mr. A.W. Murray, the Society's Non-exclusive Surveyor at New Orleans who inspected both this vessel and the sister ship "FAIRISLE" in his private capacity on the Buyers' behalf prior to purchase.

As explained to Mr. Mackirdy these documents are sent merely for your information in carrying out the re-classification survey, but it is to be clearly understood that, having regard to the special circumstances of Mr. Murray's examination, no part thereof can be accepted for re-classification purposes.

It would appear that the documents from New Orleans make reference to both vessels, so that I have instructed the Liverpool Office to send direct to you those at present in their possession for dealing with the case of the "FAIRISLE".
