I am in receipt of your letter of the 15th instant, forwarding one from The North Eastern Marine Engineering Co., Ltd., together with the enclosures advised therein, relating to a new screw shaft intended for the s.s. "HERPORT" ex "Fairport", and note that the material of this shaft has not been tested by the Society's Surveyors, but that the scantlings of the shaft as shown on the plan and the results of tests of material as shown on the Borgemaster's Certificate are in accordance with the requirements of the Rules.
