



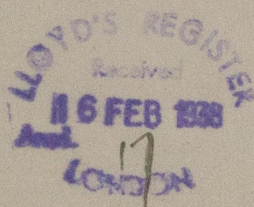

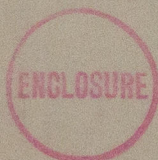
Dear Sir,
