Dear Sirs,

We beg to approach you with regard to a Tailshaft which we have in hand to the order of Messrs. Galbraith Pembroke & Co. Ltd., 7 Billiter Square, London E.C.3. originally intended for the s.s. "FAIRISLE", but which was at the time of the order not to Lloyd's Survey. ^(now Herisle) Later, and before completion, the shaft was transferred to another vessel, the s.s. "FAIRPORT", and we have now ^(now HERPORT) been asked by the Owners to proceed with its completion. When ordering the forging, which is of ingot steel, we took the precaution to stipulate that it should be equal to Lloyd's requirements, and we have a certificate from the Makers, Messrs. T.S. Forster & Sons Ltd., copy of which is enclosed herewith. A blue print of the shaft as ordered is also enclosed.

We gather that it is now intended to reclass this vessel with your Society, and shall be glad to know that the shaft will meet with your approval.
