S. With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your Bk. "KILLORAN", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them at their meeting to-day a report received from the Society's Surveyors at Hull from which it appears that the vessel has been placed in drydock, the bottom cleaned and coated and repairs effected to the rudder. The Surveyors report that the Donkey Boiler was also examined and that defects were found in the furnace and tube plate of this boiler.

In the circumstances the Class in the Register Book has been continued with fresh record of survey subject to the Donkey Boiler not being used again.
