Dear Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 7th instant intimating that the sailing ship "GRACE HARWAR" is at present discharging at Wilmington, N.C., whence she will proceed to Port Lincoln, South Australia to load for the United Kingdom or Continent and that it is proposed to carry out the Donkey Boiler Survey on her arrival in Europe. In reply I have to say that in the circumstances the Committee, who had the case before them at their meeting today, are agreeable to the survey in question being postponed for the present.
