Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 20th instant forwarding a translation of a communication you have received from Captain Gustaf Erikson regarding the ships "LAWHILL", "OLIVEBANK", "PASSAT", "KILLORAN", "GRACE HARWAR", "VIKING", "PONAPE", and "PAMIR", from which I note that Convention freeboard certificates are desired for these vessels.

With regard thereto I have to inform you that before the certificates in question can be issued in respect of these ships it will be necessary for them to be surveyed in accordance with the requirements of the International Load Line Convention, and if you will be good enough to advise me as to when and at what ports the requisite surveys can be held, I shall have pleasure in instructing the Society's Surveyors concerned to give the cases the necessary attention.

We have a letter from Captain Gustaf Erikson of Mariestad, dated 13th instant, in which he writes translated as follows:-

"As there will soon be a question of new Loadline certificates according to International Loadline Convention, one ought to get certificates from the different classification societies that the respective vessels fulfil the conditions of the Convention, and I am wondering if you could obtain these from certificates for the vessels which are classed with Lloyd's. This applies to LAWHILL, OLIVABANK, PASSAT, KILLARNA, GUST Erikson, VIKING, RONAPP and PAMIR. I am not, however, certain if the PASSAT and PAMIR have written Lloyd's freeboard certificates when they both have belonged also to Germanischer Lloyd."
