on the (Date of examination) 28th May till 3rd June 1940 19 40 ,

I have to report that I found in very poor condition and renewed all the mast spars, union screws shackles which were found in bad condition were repaired and replaced in position.

- renewed: 6 pieces rigging with 1" dia wire. iron
- 2 pieces backstays 5/8" steel wire
- 1 piece forestay 1 1/4" dia iron wire
- 4 pieces funnel guys 1" dia iron wire.
- 4 shackles 3/4" dia

Derrick, top lift, boat guys, yard arm guys which were in good condition, properly cleaned and all replaced in position.
