
I beg to inform you that the T.S.S. "LETICIA" (official No. 3704) of Willemstad. D.W.I. has been surveyed in accordance with the International Load Line Convention Act 1930 and the Freeboards assigned by the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping. London, have been marked on the vessel's sides amidships and verified by me as under:
