Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your telegram of today's date as follows:-

"Liseta Leticia Freeboard difference one foot
"six inches please report on what grounds information
"desired Dutch Commission"

and with regard thereto I shall be glad if you will inform the Dutch Commission that in the case of the "LISETA" the scantlings were considered on the basis of a restricted draught of 11'-7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " moulded, and the vessel was classed LOCAL "with Freeboard".

In the case of the "LETICIA" the minimum freeboard permitted by the Regulations was desired, the scantlings were determined accordingly and the unrestricted class LOCAL is to be assigned.
