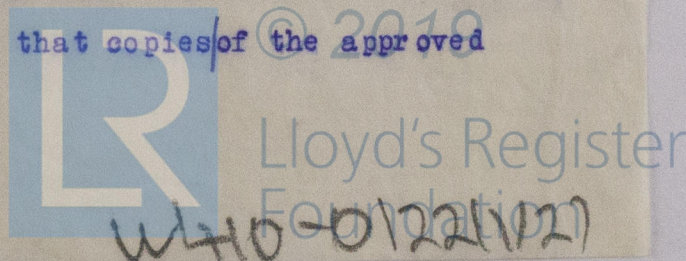
The Builders state that this vessel is to be delivered shortly. We have made repeated requests for the tonnage certificate in order that the usual freeboard report may be forwarded, but the certificate is not yet ready.

The Builders have now forwarded the certificate of tonnage for the previous sister ship of this class built by them, namely the s.s. "LISETA", and state in their letter that, as these are sister ships, the tonnages will remain unaltered. They have requested this Office to make out the necessary reports on the basis of these tonnages in order to avoid any delay.

In the circumstances the freeboard report 11 b has been prepared accordingly.

The two previous sister ships were classed 100 A 1 "with freeboard", whereas this vessel is to class 100A1.

It is understood that copies of the approved plans are in the London office.



The Builders have been requested to supply at the earliest possible moment the exact tonnages and measurements for the vessel, and these will be forwarded to you as soon as received.

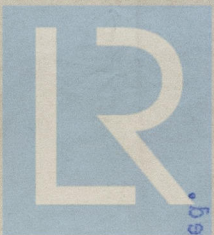
