CLASSIFICATION OF VESSELS LAID UP

With reference to the case of the steamer "LEO" (No. 28402 in the Register Book) which has been laid up for some time under the usual undertaking, I beg to acquaint you the Committee have today had before them a report of an inspection recently made of the vessel by the Society's Surveyors at Hull as a result of which they have granted an extension of class for twelve months from March 1940; and have decided to assign to the vessel a notation of "Examined 3.40 (in red)" following the procedure adopted in similar cases in the last war.

The vessel's name is accordingly being deleted from the list in this Office, of vessels laid up under the usual undertaking.
