In reply to your letter of the 29th instant respecting the freeboard assignment for the S.S. "LEO" ex "SPES" we have to state that Messrs. Ramage & Ferguson Ltd., have now received instructions from the Owners of this vessel to fit Class A closing appliances, i.e. shifting boards in channels riveted to the bulkhead, the full height of the openings in the bridge front.
