Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your freeboard report on the ex German Steamer "SPES", and with regard thereto I have to request that you will describe fully how the "steel plate bolted doors" at the bridge front are secured, whether by riveted hinges or only by hook bolts, in order that it may be seen under which class the closing appliances fall.

I have to point out that the term "door" is only applicable to permanently hinged closing appliances.

I shall be glad if you will also state whether there are 4 freeing ports on each side in the well, or if 4 is the number for both sides.

The height of the bridge omitted from your report should also be given.
