In the accompanying letter from the Wireless Operator, who desires to remain anonymous, a statement is made that this ship was loaded to a draught of 23 feet 9 or 10 inches on leaving Rosario on the 2nd July, 1932.

The draught corresponding to the freeboard assigned by this Society is 22 feet 7 inches. It would therefore appear that the ship was overloaded to the extent of 14 or 15 inches.
