With reference to Mr. Arrowsmith's conversation with Mr. Hodgson at this Office on the 5th ultimo, I shall be obliged if you will kindly let me know whether any decision has yet been reached as to the future of this vessel.

You will appreciate that the validity of the "Examined" notation assigned to the vessel has expired, and that as intimated in my letter of the 12th May last the period of grace allowed in accordance with Ministry of Transport regulations for the Annual Load Line Survey expires on the 27th instant.

I think it well to add that the limited period of time within which the casing of the port circulating pump required to be examined has expired. The Boiler Survey will become due at the end of the present month.
