
PARTICULARS OF TONNAGE.

Table with 4 columns: GROSS TONNAGE (Under Tonnage Deck 858.66, Space or spaces between Decks 8.44, Forecastle Break 162.66, Bridge space 23.07, Poop on Break 43.24, Side Houses 43.47, Deck Houses 2.59, Chart House 35.56, Excess of Hatchways 35.56), No. of Tons (1177.69), DEDUCTIONS ALLOWED (On account of space required for propelling power 376.86, On account of spaces occupied by Seamen or Apprentices, and appropriated to their use, and kept free from goods or stores of every kind, not being the personal property of the Crew 84.06, These spaces are the following, viz.:— Bridge, Poop and Two Deck Houses (Number of Seamen or Apprentices for whom accommodation is certified... 19...), Deductions under Section 79 of the Merchant Shipping Act, 1894, and Section 54 of the Merchant Shipping Act, 1906, as follows:— Masters Accommodation 7.38, Chart Space 2.59, Boatswains Store 4.35, Water Ballast Spaces 47.21), No. of Tons (522.45).

NOTE 1.—The tonnage of the engine room spaces below the Upper Deck is 165.06 tons, and the tonnage of the total spaces framed in above the Upper Deck for propelling machinery and for light and air is 43.78 tons.

NOTE 2.—The undermentioned spaces above the Upper Deck are not included in the cubical contents forming the ship's register tonnage. Forecastle L. 21.0' = 21.71 tons. Open space at fore end of poop L. 30.0' = 46.45 "
