Nature of Survey

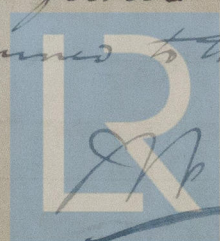
First entry

It is submitted that before this case reaches the consideration of the Committee, the Belfast Surveyors should be reminded that the arrangement of bulkheads was approved for this vessel, subject to the following notation being made in the Register Book viz:- 7 BH, 5 BH to Upper deck, 2 BH to Second deck and to a letter being received from the Owners desiring the arrangement of bulkheads in question. The Surveyors should therefore be requested to forward the Owners letter agreeing to the arrangement of the bulkheads & at the same time it should be pointed out to them that they should have made it clear in their report as to their opinion that the vessel should be classed +100A1 'Shade deck'; that this is subject to the above notation regarding the bulkheads being assigned, and they should be requested to do this in all future cases.

The report should be returned to the Surveyors for correction.
