Gentlemen,

I beg to inform you that I attended yesterday at the official trial trip of the T.S.S. "ZORA" and examined the machinery and boilers under full power. The safety valves have been tested and lift main boilers at 205 lbs and donkey boilers at 103 lbs, the washers being unchanged. The maximum revolutions of the engines was 92. The vessel is now on the 48 hour trial and is expected at Belfast on Saturday evening when the Contractors party will be landed, after which she is to be brought by her own crew to Greenock to take in stores.
