
I have to inform you that the S.S."TRURO", Messrs. The John Duthie Torry S.B.Co's No.459, has proceeded to your port for the purpose of receiving her machinery, and to complete the survey for classification the following remains to be done:- Boat deck and casings to be hosed after the machinery is on board and casings riveted, tunnel top to be tested by a hose after the shaft is in position, pillars in engine room to be riveted, windlass, winches and steering gear to be tried under steam, Downton pump to be tested, electric light and radiators to be tried on completion, relieving tackle to be fitted aft and freeboard certificates to be issued on receipt of Official Number.

I shall therefore be glad if you will be good enough to give the case the necessary attention, and on completion of the work to your satisfaction, to forward a report on form No.8 with a view to the classification of the vessel.
