

S'S. "WOLFSBURG"

This vessel is at present under survey for Classification at Falmouth.

She is a sister vessel to the S.S. "ASCHENBURG" which was built in Germany at the same time.

The "ASCHENBURG" has just been classed 100AI, S.S. No.1,21.

The "WOLFSBURG" was surveyed by the Surveyors to this Society in Germany while building, the principal parts of the vessel were erected but the survey was discontinued before the vessel was launched.

It is submitted the reports <sup>(hull & machinery)</sup> etc., should be forwarded to the Falmouth Surveyors for their guidance in carrying out the survey.

It would be observed that the scantlings of the different parts of the vessel are given on the First Entry Report.

The Surveyors should hold the Special Survey No.1 <sup>(hull & machinery)</sup> as was done in the case of the "ASCHENBURG", and which is now classed 100AI with this Society.

The equipment should be examined and the anchor and chain test Certificates produced before the Figure 1 can be considered.
