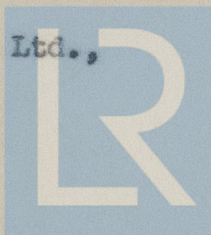
I should add I have been directed by the Committee to express their deep sympathy with you in the losses you have sustained since the outbreak of hostilities.
