FREEBOARD REPORT on the ss. Hamilton

It is submitted the Freeboards given on the accompanying form, being those required by the Tables, merit approval, subject to

1. the heaving surface of the fore-and-afters, where 2" being made reasonably in accordance with Convention requirements;
2. suitable provision being made for rigging lifelines as proposed;
3. fittings for special lashings being provided in view of the width of the hatchway.

The existing freeboards being more favourable than those computed under the Convention have been reassigned.

It is further submitted the freeboard certificate may be sent to the Belfast Sprays for issue when the freeboards have been washed & verified, the conditions of survey usual complied with, and special Survey 31st completed.


