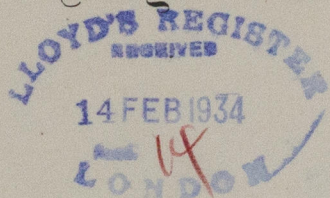

These plates are badly corroded & the riveting is not in good condition. Item 8. It is the cleats only that require to be repaired on No 20 hatch. The coaming is in good condition.
