S. Further to my letter of the 20th instant respecting the steamer "TRITON" (No.35508 in the Register Book), I have to acquaint you I am now in receipt of a cablegram from the Registro Italiano, Genoa, dated the 20th instant, a translation of which reads as follows :-

"THE STEAMER TRITON 85296 IN YOUR BOOK BOUGHT BY MESSRS. FRANCESCO GALLI OF GENOA WHO INTEND TO RETAIN DUAL CLASS. IF ALL IS IN ORDER WITH REGARD TO YOUR SURVEYS WILL YOU PLEASE INSTRUCT YOUR MANCHESTER SURVEYORS TO ISSUE A PROVISIONAL CERTIFICATE ON OUR ACCOUNT WITH THE CHARACTERISTICS 100A 1 Nav I AND A PROVISIONAL FREEBOARD CERTIFICATE BOTH VALID UNTIL THE VESSELS ARRIVAL IN ITALY."

With regard thereto, I shall be glad if, provided you are satisfied that the sale of the vessel to Messrs. Francesco Galli has been definitely completed, you will carry out the necessary inspections. I enclose a small supply of the R.I. forms for this purpose, copies of which should be forwarded to this Office, together with official reports on forms 8 and 9 - also in duplicate.

For your guidance I enclose a specimen form of certificate of Registro Italiano class which has been issued in similar cases, and I may say that a fee of £10-10-0 for
