Dear Sir,

We have been requested by the owners of the steamer "BOGØ" - in order to obtain the Danish Freeboard for wood cargo and wood deck cargo assigned by the Ministry of Trade and Shipping - to supply them with the following particulars of the computation of the Freeboard assigned by this Society to that vessel, namely:-

1. Ordinary summer freeboard in salt water.
 - a) corresponding summer freeboard if a complete super-structure were fitted,
 - b) effective length of erections.
2. The length outside stem and sternpost measured on the load-line.
3. Extreme breadth outside shellplating.
4. Depth of hold, corresponding to Underdeck tonnage.
5. Depth moulded.
6. Depth of framing.
7. Sparring.
