Dear Sir,

With regard to your letter "F" of the 17th October for the above vessel, we herewith enclose the freeboard verification form.

The Special Survey N°1 has now been completed and the conditions of assignment complied with, which are as follows:

- 1) Air pipe openings fitted with wood plugs.
- 2) Steel clips fitted to the hatch coamings, port and starboard in the forward and after wells and portable stanchions made and to fit port or starboard as required in conjunction with steel wire lifeline which is attached to the end bulkheads of the superstructure.
- 3) Locks and fastenings on doors in forecastle bulkhead and machinery casings placed in order.
- 4) Saddle hatch coaming angles renewed as required.
- 5) Wood hatch covers renewed as required.

The new freeboard certificate and certified copy have been issued to the Master and we also enclose herewith the old certificate in duplicate for cancellation.
