efficient means being provided for closing the air pipe openings & suitable provision being made for rigging lifelines, which should be available for use in any part of the ship which might have to be used by the crew in the regular working of the ship. the closing appliances on the doors of the forecabin bulkhead and machinery casings being placed in good order. the saddle hatch coaming angles being made good to the satisfaction of the Surveyor. Wood hatch covers being made good to the Surveyor's satisfaction.

The Convention freeboards being less favorable than existing freeboards, the latter have been re-assessed
