R. With reference to my letter of the 10th ultimo respecting the motorship "BEULAH", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have again had the case of this vessel under consideration, and as it is understood that she has been declared a Constructive Total Loss, I am directed to inform you that, in all the circumstances, it has been decided to make a record of "Sunk in port 12,37 - Refloated" against the vessel's name in the Society's Register Book, in accordance with the terms of my letter of the 15th March last.

I may add, however, that in the event of the vessel being repaired to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors, the notation of casualty will be withdrawn immediately upon reclassification by this Society.
