

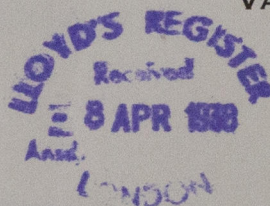

Dear Sir:-

I have to acknowledge your letter of March 15th. enclosing a copy of your letter of the same date, to the Owners of the M.V. "BEULAH".

This vessel has now been raised, and in company with the Owners' and Underwriters' Surveyors I examined the ship on dry dock at Victoria yesterday.

There is practically no under water damage, but considerable repairs will be necessary internally and to the erections, accommodations, bridge and main deck, the latter having collapsed.

Specifications have been drawn up, and tenders will be received on March 29th., after which a decision regarding repairs, or otherwise, will be made.

In my opinion the cost of repairs will very nearly reach the insured value.
