All the machinery and boilers of this vessel, except the steam turbines, were constructed and installed on board by Messrs D. Rowan & Co. Glasgow.

The two steam turbines only, not including the reduction gear, were made by Messrs Metropolitan Vickers Electrical Co. Manchester.

It is the usual practice to insert the Engine makers name in the Register Book which in this case is Messrs Vickers Co as makers of the turbines.

Messrs Rowan consider that as the greater percentage of the machinery was made by them it is important that their name should appear in the Register Book.

It is submitted that Messrs Rowan should be asked to state whether an insertion in column 13 of the Register Book as follows would meet their case. viz:-

2 Steam Turbines geared to 1 Screw Shaft. 200hp.

2 DB & 2 SB. 24 cf. GS 420. HS 19266. (7)
