A. I have to acknowledge the due receipt of your letter of the 15th instant respecting the Turbines Nos. 1725/6, constructed by Messrs. Metropolitan Vickers Ltd., for Messrs. D. Rowan & Co., from which I note that the latter firm state that the fee chargeable for the portion of the engines constructed at Manchester is payable by Messrs. Metropolitan Vickers Ltd.

The Manchester Surveyors have been informed accordingly and have been requested to render an account for £12. 12. 9, being one-third of the fee for the survey of the engines only.

I think it well to add that as the Nominal Horse Power is 1113, the total fees chargeable will be:-

First Entry Fee.....	£ 3. 0. 0.
Survey Fee.....	72. 16. 6.
	<u>75. 16. 6.</u>

and that one-half of this total will be chargeable for the survey of the engines only viz: £37. 18. 3. For the survey of the Turbines, as stated above, the Manchester Surveyors have been informed that one-third of the engine fee, or £12. 12. 9 should be collected by them.

I take this opportunity to send herewith the Manchester First Entry Report No. 4523 on the Turbines in question, for the information of the Surveyors in completing the survey.
