With reference to Mr. Chapman's letter of the 24th ultimo respecting the fees for the survey during construction of the H.P. and L.P. Turbines, made by Messrs. Metropolitan Vickers Ltd., for Messrs. D. Rowan & Co., your first entry report No. 4523, I have to inform you that I have been in communication with the Society's Glasgow Office with regard to the matter and I am informed that Messrs. Rowan & Co., state that the fee chargeable for the parts of the engines constructed at your port is payable by Messrs. Metropolitan Vickers Ltd.

In these circumstances, I have to inform you that one-third of the fee due for the survey of the engines only will be chargeable for the work done at your port, and as the total fee for the survey of the engines is £37. 18. 3, you will be good enough to render an account to Messrs. Metropolitan Vickers Ltd., for £12. 12. 9 for the survey carried out at their works.
