Ltd., I beg to acquaint you that Messrs. Rowan state that the fee chargeable for the portion of the Engines constructed at Manchester is payable by Messrs. Metropolitan Vickers Ltd.

The Surveyor considers that one third of the engine fee (namely one sixth of the total machinery fee) should be charged for the survey of these turbines, the nominal horse power being 1113.


