Nature of Survey _____

The Middlesbrough Surveyors report this ship placed in dry dock, the bottom cleaned and coated, stream line plates welded to the rudder and similar plates fitted and electrically welded to the stern frame as approved.

The ship has been shortened 37'-6", ~~the midship deep tank and the deckhouses under bridge dispensed with~~ and alterations carried out to the Surveyors' satisfaction. (as per approved plans)

It is submitted the ship appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 4,35.
