Dear Sirs, it is not practicable to adhere generally to the
M. I am in receipt of Mr. Scorer's letter of the 22nd
instant enclosing a plan, in duplicate, shewing a suggested
altered arrangement at the junction of the main deck after
shortening in the case of the S.S. "MANGALORE", and the contents
have been duly noted.

With regard thereto I have to state that the
arrangements proposed do not provide an adequate means of
securing continuity of the deck plating outside the line of
the casing, and you should confer with the Builders with a
view to seeing if it is not practicable to adhere generally
to the principle embodied in the proposal shewn on the plan
approved on the 13th December last, in which continuity is
maintained by through riveting in double riveted deck angles.

The plan in question is returned herewith.
