Dear Sir,

We are forwarding herewith Freeboard Verification Form for the s.s. "TIBERTON", and have to state that the following items have been carried out to comply with the Freeboard Assignment :-

- (1) One tarpaulin and efficient battening arrangements fitted to the coal hatchways on the freeboard deck in the bridge space.
- (2) Wood plugs fitted to all air pipes.
- (3) Manilla lifelines fitted in after well port and starboard sides from poop to bridge bulkheads.
- (4) Fidley top part renewed, grating covers placed in good condition and hinges of same part renewed.

New locks and handles fitted to Engine Room Doors on bridge and upper deck capable of being operated from both sides, and hinged clip fitted to upper portion of two piece boiler room doors on bridge deck, operated from both sides.
