Casualty 21st December, 1939.

Particulars of Casualty This vessel is reported to have been in collision off the Yorkshire coast on the 21st December, 1939.

She was badly damaged and taken in tow by another trawler, but after five hours she began to settle down and she eventually sank.

No reply has been received to the casualty notice addressed to the Owners on the 5th instant.

Bombed Ship Sunk in Collision

THE Hull trawler Dromio (380 tons), which was unsuccessfully bombed by German planes last Sunday, sank in the North Sea on Thursday after a collision with an Italian steamer.

The Dromio was on her way to the fishing grounds. Sixteen members of her crew were landed at a north-east port last night.

TRAWLER SINKS AFTER COLLISION

The British trawler Dromio has sunk after having been in collision with an Italian steamer, believed to be the Valdarno, off the Yorkshire coast. The Dromio was badly damaged and taken in tow by another trawler, but sank before reaching port. Her crew of 15 Hull fishermen were transferred to the other trawler. The Dromio, of 380 tons gross, was owned by Hellyer Bros. Ltd., of Hull.
