She was held fast amidships among rocks and water was in all her holds. (Salvage operations were commenced but had to be given up.

No reply has been received to the casualty notice addressed to the Owners on the 19th ultimo. The Bergen Surveyor, however, has stated the vessel is a total loss and that she has been sold for breaking up where she lies.
