
M. Sir,

We are forwarding under separate cover a Profile & Deck Plan, and a Detail Plan showing proposed second deck to be fitted in the steamer "BELGIER". The plans are in duplicate and it is requested that both copies should be signed.

Several vessels of this type are being purchased by the Cie Belge Maritime du Congo from the Lloyd Royal Belge; after their transfer they will be laid off and a second deck will be fitted in them. Messrs. The Antwerp Engineering Co and Messrs. Soc. An. John Cockerill have secured the contracts to fit the deck & make ~~the~~ other alterations, and the plan submitted will be taken as a standard. It is, therefore, requested that the scantlings should be modified, if possible, so that the minimum requirements are shown. The new Owners do not wish for pillars in way of the hatches either in the holds or tween decks.

An alternative plan for the hatch girder, prepared by Messrs. S.An. John Cockeril, is also being forwarded, marked "Alternative Plan".

The plans approved in June last showing pillars in way of the hatches, as well as the First Entry Plans of the vessel are also being forwarded.


