The undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owner's Superintendent attend on board of the steamer "KABINDA", of Antwerp, 5077 tons gross, on the 14th September 1927 whilst the vessel was lying afloat in the Bassin Canal, Antwerp, for the purpose of witnessing the test of the large derrick.

The derrick having been raised to an angle of about 35 degrees from the deck, it was found that the derrick & all permanent attachments therewith, satisfactorily withstood a static load of forty one tons.

The load of forty one tons was the maximum which could be applied by the vessel's steam winches.
