Nature of Survey.....

The Antwerp Surveyors report this vessel placed in dry dock, the bottom cleaned and coated and damage through heavy weather and fire repaired as follows:- 2 shell plates and 4 deck plates renewed, 7 beams, 1 stringer plate and 5 deck plates repaired and minor repairs effected.

A bower anchor has been temporarily placed on board and it is stated this will be replaced by another anchor on vessel's return from the present voyage.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed, with record of survey 2.28, subject to the equipment of anchors being placed in order on vessel's return from the present voyage, as recommended.
